<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this term we will be focusing on:

- Perimeter of rectangles and rectilinear shapes
- Understanding and calculating area
- Exploring and converting units of measure
- Solving measure problems
- Solving money problems
- Developing understanding of angles
- Developing understanding of 2D shapes
- Reasoning about symmetry
- Co-ordinates
- Number systems and sequences
- Understanding 3D shapes
- Solving problems with 3D shapes

In our History topic Were the Vikings raiders, traders or settlers we will be learning about:

- Investigating whether the Vikings were raiders, traders of settlers.
- Making boats to see if the Vikings were engineers and exploring causes and consequences.
- Making deductions from sources, identifying the author's viewpoint and identifying how this impacts the accuracy of the source.

In our **Geography** topic on **rivers** we will be learning about:

- What are rivers?
- What is a river's place in the water cycle?
- The names and locations of major UK rivers.
- How major rivers are used.

In **Science** during Summer 1 we will be focusing on classification and changing habitats.

In Summer 2 we will be learning about how to make connections between our scientific knowledge and enquiries. In Art, we will be learning about:
